RESOLUTION 17 - 2021

A resolution stating Okanogan County's commitment of local funds to the state of Washington Hazard Mitigation Grant Program application for the Fire Hardening – Tunk Mountain project.

WHEREAS, Okanogan County's is applying to the state of Washington Hazard Mitigation Grant Program for the Fire Hardening – Tunk Mountain project; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Hardening – Tunk Mountain project is projected to cost \$263,774 including sales tax; and

WHEREAS, the state of Washington Hazard Mitigation Grant Program awards provide 75% of the project expenses to successful applicants; and

WHEREAS, the state of Washington may elect to provide 12.5% of the project costs; and

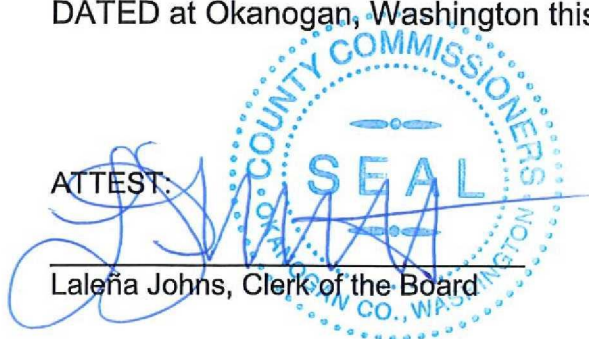
WHEREAS, the state of Washington Hazard Mitigation Grant Program requires the applicant to commit local funds for 25% of the projected project costs should the state of Washington not provide funds for 12.5% of project costs; and

WHEREAS, the local commitment of funds at 25% of projected project costs is \$65,943 and should the state of Washington provide 12.5% of project costs the local commitment of 12.5% of projected project costs is \$32,971.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners commit to providing local funding of up to 25% of the projected project costs to complete the Fire Hardening – Tunk Mountain project.
