RESOLUTION 17 - 2024

A Resolution amending Resolution 193-2023 Task Force Sergeant

WHEREAS, Section 3.1 of the Okanogan County Personnel Manual provides that a classification system inventorying the duties and responsibilities of each position shall group individual position into classifications based upon the similarities in job duties and responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, April 4, 2016 Joshua Petker was assigned as the Supervisor of the Task Force, for these duties Joshua Petker was receiving Entry Sergeant pay and detective pay; and

WHEREAS, Joshua Petker is currently classified as a Field Deputy and receives his Sergeant's pay as a Sergeant pay differential; and

WHEREAS, the position title of Field Deputy does not accurately reflect his position as a Sergeant for the Task Force; and

WHEREAS, the fund split adopted in Resolution 193-2023 will expense more funds then was budgeted for the Task Force Sergeant in the 2024 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners that effective November 21, 2023 that the title of Field Deputy position SHF017FD0-013 be changed to Task Force Sergeant with funding to be split as follows:

Sheriff's Bars Code 001.017.021.521.21.11.04 (~~88.88%~~) (92.25)

Task Force Bars Code 132.000.023.521.23.11.014 (41.42%) (7.75%)

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that at such time as the Task Force Sergeant is no longer an employee of Okanogan County, position SHF017FDO-013 will return to a Field Deputy position.
