RESOLUTION 22 -2023

A resolution authorizing the hiring of Courthouse Security Officers

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners recognizes the need for security officers in the Courthouse for the safety and security of the employees and members of the public; and

WHEREAS, in the past Courthouse Security has been provided by a Corrections Deputy from the Sheriff's Office and because of current staffing levels this option is not available; and

WHEREAS, the County requested bids from three (3) companies to provide two (2) armed Courthouse Security Officers; and

WHEREAS, Pacific Security and Phoenix Protective Corporation responded to this request for two (2) armed security officers.

WHEREAS, they have provided email quotes to Okanogan County at the following daily rates Pacific Security \$560.00 per day and Phoenix Protective Corporation \$1,898.26 per day.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners that the lowest quote was received from Pacific Security and that they be selected to provide Courthouse Security Officers for Okanogan County and additional security officers as needed.
