

**OKANOGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS'**

**RESOLUTION 22 - 2024**

*A resolution to add additional duties and salary adjustment to the Dependency Unit Manager position to become the Adult Felony Drug Court Program Coordinator*

**WHEREAS**, Resolution 122-2006 authorizes for the establishment of therapeutic court programs for Okanogan County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Okanogan County Superior Court has established Adult Felony Drug Court and Family Dependency Treatment Court programs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Judicial Assistant Bailiff Position has always been part of the Drug Court Team and has been a special assistant to the Superior Court Judges in that role; and

**WHEREAS**, the Judicial Assistant Bailiff Position is currently vacant and unfilled; and

**WHEREAS**, there is now a need and desire by the Superior Court to increase the duties and responsibilities of the Dependency Unit Manager in the Juvenile Court equating to 20 hours a month as a program coordinator to perform court case management, LEA coordination and data collection and management for the Adult Felony Drug Court program.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners that effective January 22, 2024, that the Judicial Assistant Bailiff position receive an additional compensation in the amount of \$400 a month from CJTA Funds BARS Code Number 001.015 due to the increase duties and responsibilities as the program coordinator in support of the Adult Felony Drug Court.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, if CJTA funds become unavailable to support the position then FUND 143 will be used to support the position.
