RESOLUTION 24 - 2021

A resolution approving a late proposal for use of HB2163 Homeless Housing funds as recommended by the Housing Coalition

WHEREAS, the Okanogan County Community Action Council (OCCAC) published a Request for Proposal (RFP) notice for use of Homeless Housing Funds in 2020 that were available through Okanogan County from legislation known as the HB2163 Homeless Housing Assistance Act; and

WHEREAS, Oroville Housing Authority (OHA) was unable to submit by the deadline a Request for Proposal response for 2021 funds allocation; and

WHEREAS, The Housing Coalition received and approved a late proposal from OHA which was provided to the Board of County Commissioners on March 2, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the proposal is to help cover operating costs of the Oroville Winter Emergency Camp winter shelter that is run by the Oroville Housing Authority operating under RCW 35.82; and

WHEREAS, operating costs include costs from November 16, 2020 through April 16th, 2021.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners, that the following allocation of Homeless Housing Funds, from county Fund 142, for use in 2021, are approved as follows:

Oroville Housing Authority \$35,800

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Clerk of the Board is directed to prepare a contract between Okanogan County and Oroville Housing Authority for use of the Homeless Housing funds in 2021 for the Oroville Homeless Shelter emergency shelter operation costs.
