

**OKANOGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
RESOLUTION 25- 2021**

*A resolution allowing two additional temporary flagger positions within the
Public Works Department for the 2021 construction season*

WHEREAS, increased traffic coupled with workload for the 2021 construction season within Public Works Road Maintenance Areas 3 and 4 has created a need; and

WHEREAS, flaggers are necessary for the safety of the crews and motoring public; and

WHEREAS, using current road crew employees as flaggers will reduce the workforce and result in less efficient prosecution of the work needed; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners reviewed the needs of the Public Works Department in regards to flaggers along with the request from the County Engineer to allow for the hiring of two additional temporary flaggers for the safe and efficient operations of the Areas 3 and 4 crews.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, each temporary employee shall not work longer than 6 months.


