RESOLUTION 27 – 2021

A resolution creating one new Lead Field Technician Position, reclassifying one current Field Technician to Lead Field Technician, and defunding the Assistant Manager Position

WHEREAS, the Noxious Weed Control Manager has met with the Board of County Commissioners and provided a plan to restructure the Field Technicians in the Noxious Weed Department; and

WHEREAS, the Manager has requested the creation of two (2) Lead Field Technician positions, provided a job description, and salary survey with a suggested grade of 25; and

WHEREAS, the Manager has requested one current Field Technician position (NOX103FA0-001) be reclassified to Lead Field Technician and to create one additional Lead Field Technician position; and

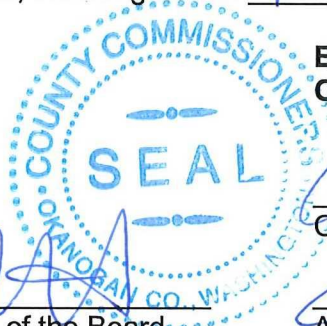
WHEREAS, the Manager has also requested the Assistant Manager position (NOX103AMR-002) be defunded until such time a person can be trained in the future; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners to enable their Department to operate in an efficient and effective manner to serve the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED effective on the date of signing, the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners approve the creation of a Lead Field Technician position (Grade 25), the reclassification of a Field Technician position to Lead Field Technician (Grade 25) and to defund the Assistant Manager position.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, BARS Code shall be created or assigned for the Lead Field Technician positions as needed.
