RESOLUTION 28 -2021

A resolution promoting Veterans Service Officer Assistant

WHEREAS, the Veterans Service Officer is resigning as of March 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Section 3.3.2 of the County Personnel Manual provides for the promotion of an employee into a higher classification; and

WHEREAS, Section of the County Personnel Manual also provides for a promoted employee to be placed at the first step of the new ranges, which is at least five percent (5%) higher than the prior rate of pay; and

WHEREAS, Tom Even was hired as Veterans Service Officer Assistant, position #COM007CK2-001, on May 21, 2020 and has obtained the required certifications to perform the Veterans Service Officer position; and


WHEREAS, Tom Even has proven work performance, training, experience, and increased responsibilities are good cause to promote him to the vacated position of Veterans Service Officer.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners that effective April 1, 2021, Tom Even is promoted from the classification of Veterans Service Officer Assistant, Grade 10, Step 1, to the classification of Veterans Service Officer, position #COM007CK3-002, Grade 16, Step 1.
