RESOLUTION 33 - 2021

A resolution prohibiting county employees and family members from bidding on publicly auctioned county surplus property

WHEREAS, the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners (BOCC) approved resolution 22-2013 which is the County's Asset Policy; and

WHEREAS, Section 6.3 of the County's Asset Policy prohibits employees from taking possession of any county owned asset, except by means of bidding at public auction as allowed by law; and

WHEREAS, MRSC recommends and RCW 42.23.030 supports the prohibition of county officials, county employees and their spouses, dependents or any other person acting on the employee's behalf from bidding on county owned surplus property at public auction or acquiring county property by direct sales.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners hereby amends and clarifies resolution 22-2013 section 6.3 the following into its policy:

Okanogan County employees including elected officials, department heads, their spouses, dependents or any other person acting on the employee's behalf are prohibited from bidding and/or acquiring surplus property from the agency in which the employee is employed. Employees may bid and/or acquire surplus property from other state agencies if acquired through a competitive bidding process.
