

OKANOGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS'

RESOLUTION 34 - 2024

A resolution by the Okanogan Board of County Commissioners reducing the rental fee for use of the Agri-plex by Sunrise Chevrolet RV Show

WHEREAS: Okanogan County owns and operates the Agriplex facility located on the Okanogan County Fairgrounds, and

WHEREAS: The Okanogan Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) finds that it serves the public interest to make the facility, in whole or in part, available for use by the public, and

WHEREAS: earlier this year Sunrise RV Show verbally scheduled and advertised their 2024 annual RV Show event at the Fairgrounds Agriplex on a weekend that conflicted with another contracted scheduled event; and

WHEREAS: due to the conflict, BOCC worked with Sunrise Chevrolet and cancelled the 2024 RV Show that had already been advertised for the conflicted weekend; and

WHEREAS: Okanogan County should generally receive some sort of compensation for the use of its facilities to avoid an improper gift of public funds; and

WHEREAS: the BOCC believes some kind of compensation should be considered that would be fair to both Sunrise Chevrolet and the county for the rescheduled event;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED: The Okanogan County Board of County Commissioners hereby directs staff to reduce the Sunrise Chevrolet 2024 RV Show event fee by \$1500 for rental of the Fairgrounds Agriplex as just compensation for the rescheduled event to later date.
