RESOLUTION 41-2021

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the Okanogan County Board of Commissioners to promote economic development within the county; and,

WHEREAS, the Okanogan County Board of Commissioners' have supported the provision of sufficient fire safety; and,

WHEREAS, a design and feasibility analysis is required prior to the Loomis Fire District #10 application of grant funds to construct a new Fire Hall and Training Center; and,

WHEREAS, a USDA Rural Business Development Grant application is submitted for the grant funds that would fund the study consultant; and

WHEREAS, said feasibility study will demonstrate that the potential exists to construct the needed Fire Hall; and,

WHEREAS, in-kind services will be donated from the County and Economic Alliance staff; and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Okanogan County Board of Commissioners authorizes use of county staff time for in-kind donation amounting to 5% of the grant awarded, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Okanogan County Board of Commissioners authorizes submittal of the USDA Rural Business Development Grant application that will benefit Loomis Fire District #10.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Chris Branch, Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, or Laleña Johns, Clerk of the Board is authorized to apply for, sign and administer the USDA Rural Business Development Grant documents that will benefit Loomis Fire District #10.
