RESOLUTION 48 - 2022

A resolution increasing a revolving fund from \$10,000 to \$25,000 to process Trial Jury Venire and Election Board services

WHEREAS, The Okanogan County Auditor was authorized a revolving fund to process jury venire and election board services in the amount of \$5,000 by resolution 11-2001; and

WHEREAS, The jury venire revolving account amount was increased by another \$5,000 by Resolution 115-2001 due to increased need; and

WHEREAS, The Okanogan County Auditor has been informed by Superior Court staff that the current trial jury venire will be close to \$25,000; and

WHEREAS, The Jury Venire revolving account also processes the District Court jury venires; and

WHEREAS, there are some potentially large trials still to come this year; and

WHEREAS, the Okanogan County Auditor is requesting an increase of \$15,000 in order to process the anticipated Superior Court jury venire.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Okanogan County Treasurer is hereby directed to issue a Treasurer's check in the amount of \$15,000 to the Okanogan County Auditor for the Jury Venire revolving account,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said \$15,000 is to be deposited to a revolving checking account and used for jury venire and election board services bringing the total of the revolving account amount to \$25,000.
