RESOLUTION 49 - 2022

A resolution appointing Chief Civil Deputy Prosecuting Attorney

WHEREAS, advertising for the vacated Chief Civil Deputy Prosecuting Attorney position took place within the Prosecuting Attorney's Office; and

WHEREAS, the decision was made to promote Esther Milner to Chief Civil Deputy Prosecuting Attorney due to her education, skills, and previous working experience; and

WHEREAS, on some occasions the Prosecutor is out of the office and cannot meet the deadline for signing and submitting vouchers, employee claim forms, and timesheets; and

WHEREAS, Esther Milner has been acting Chief Civil Deputy Prosecuting Attorney since the departure of the previous employee.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners that effective April 4, 2022, Esther Milner will fill the vacated position of Chief Civil Deputy Prosecuting Attorney.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the absence of the Prosecuting Attorney, Chief Civil Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, Esther Milner, is hereby authorized to sign timesheets (including overtime), employee expense claims and vouchers that are processed through the Okanogan County Prosecutor's Office subject to final approval by the Board of County Commissioners as set forth in the Revised Code of Washington.


