**RESOLUTION 59 - 2022**

*A Resolution approving temporary staff support in the Treasures' Office*

**WHEREAS**, the Treasures' Office has been unable to fill the vacant positions within their office with a qualified applicant; and

**WHEREAS**, the work load is such that the duties and responsibilities cannot all be distributed to other support staff; and

**WHEREAS**, Rachel Patrick who has recently resigned her position in Treasures' Office has agreed to work on Friday's on a temporary basis to assist with the work load and to help train her replacement;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners that Rachel Patrick is authorized to temporarily provide assistance and training within the Treasures' Office on Friday's at the rate of \$21.150 per hour not to exceed 8 hours per week.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the authorization for temporary help within the Treasures' Office is authorized beginning May 6, 2022 and ending June 24, 2022 at which time the Treasures' Office may request the Board of Okanogan County commissioners review the situation for further consideration.
