RESOLUTION 59 - 2023

A resolution to establish a fund to receipt and disburse funds of the Washington State Allocation Agreement ("Allocation Agreement II") Governing the Allocation of funds paid by certain settling Opioid Manufacturers and Pharmacies

WHEREAS, on March 14, 2023, the Okanogan County Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) participated in the Allocation Agreement for opioid settlement to receive Washington State Opioid Abatement funds; and

WHEREAS, the BOCC executed and signed one Washington Memorandum of Understanding between Settling Entities that were identified in the Allocation Agreement as Walmart, Teva, Allergan, CVS and Walgreens; and

WHEREAS, as specified in each of the Settlements, the Washington Abatement Amount will vary dependent on the percentage of Participating Local Governments and whether there are any Later Litigating subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, to properly receive and expend said settlement funds the county must create a suitable fund for that purpose;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Opioid Abatement Fund be created as fund 173; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the commissioners hereby direct the County Treasurer and Auditor to establish the fund for the purposes of receipting and disbursing the Opioid Abatement funds associated with the Allocation Agreement for Washington State Opioid Abatement.
