

**OKANOGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS'**

**RESOLUTION 59 - 2024**

*A resolution increasing the Grounds Keeper position from .50 FTE up to .75 FTE during peak work time*

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners (BOCC) approved Resolution 118-2022 and 24-2023 regarding the Maintenance Grounds Keeper position; and

**WHEREAS**, the Maintenance Supervisor has requested an increase in hours for the grounds keeper position to adequately care for the grounds and provide more flexibility during peak work times; and

**WHEREAS**, the upkeep of the facility grounds is more than a .50 FTE can efficiently cover; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners recognizes the necessity to maintain the facility grounds and wish to provide adequate staffing levels to cover the tasks;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners that effective May 1, 2024 the Grounds Keeper position #MNT009CS2-002 be authorized up to .75 FTE; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, resolutions 118-2022 and 24-2023 are hereby amended.
