RESOLUTION 60 - 2021

A resolution to increase Permit Technician position from .75 FTE to Full-time in the Building Department

WHEREAS, the Building Department employs a 30 hour per week part-time (.75 FTE) Clerk position to primarily review and assist in issuing building permits; and

WHEREAS, the demand for building permits and the general work load has increased over the past several years; and

WHEREAS, the incumbent of the Permit Technician position, Melissa Eylar, agrees to assist with the demand of the Okanogan County Building Department and support the citizens of Okanogan County; and

WHEREAS, after careful review, the Building Official for the County has requested the Permit Technician position increase to full-time; and

WHEREAS, the Okanogan County Commissioners recognize the necessity for the Building Department to be staffed at a level that allows it to operate efficiently and serve the public in an organized and timely manner.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners that effective May 21, 2021, the Permit Technician position occupied by Melissa Eylar will be increased from .75 FTE to a full-time position.
