

OKANOGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS'
RESOLUTION 60-2023

A Resolution increasing the per day salary of the Board of Equalization members.

WHEREAS: RCW 84.48.010 states members of the board must receive a per diem amount as set by the county legislative authority for each day of actual attendance of the meeting of the board of equalization to be paid out of the current expense fund of the county; and

WHEREAS: Okanogan County resolution 107-2020 approved a \$75 per hearing and training day for the members of the Board of Equalization (BOE), and

WHEREAS: On April 11, 2023 the current Board of Equalization members requested a salary increase to better attract potential members for appointment and to better carry out the duties and responsibilities of the board, and

WHEREAS the Board of County Commissioners agreed that an increase in the BOE salary was reasonable and necessary; and

WHEREAS: the Okanogan County Board of County Commissioners finds that it will serve the public's interest to ensure adequate compensation and participation of BOE board members.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED; the Okanogan County Board of County Commissioners hereby replace resolution 107-2020 and authorizes \$160 each day to each BOE board member for actual attendance of scheduled hearings and required trainings. In addition, members will use the same mileage rate as set by the Board of County Commissioners for use of personally owned vehicles for business purposes to attend BOE scheduled hearings and required training; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED; the Board of County Commissioners further directs the payroll change to be set and the corresponding paperwork submitted to the County Auditor's office.




