

OKANOGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS'

RESOLUTION 68 - 2024

A resolution in the matter of declaring Public Works and Building Department county-owned property surplus to the needs of the county and ordering the sale thereof via public auction sale by either electronic media or by physical auction sales.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Revised Code of Washington 36.34 the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners (BOCC) proposes to conduct a public hearing to hear a proposal to dispose of county owned property and admit evidence for and against the proposed action and designate the sale to be conducted via public auction sale by electronic media; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with RCW 36.34 legal notices were published for two consecutive weeks in the May 8 & 9, 2024 and May 15 & 16, 2024, editions of the Gazette Tribune/Methow Valley News, which are the county's legal newspaper of record, with publication setting forth the hearing date of May 21, 2024 at 11:00 a.m. The hearing set above is for the purpose of receiving both written and verbal testimony from the public on whether or not the property proposed for sale is surplus to the County's needs to be sold via Electronic Public Auction; and

WHEREAS, once the items have been declared surplus to the needs of Okanogan County it is the intention of Okanogan County to sell the items via public surplus auction sale by either electronic media or by physical public auction.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners hereby declares items described and listed as Attachment "A" surplus to the needs of the county and orders all listed items sold to the highest bidder at a sale to be conducted via electronic public surplus auction sale in accordance with RCW 36.14.145 or by physical surplus auction; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that proceeds from the sales are to be credited to the fund from which the original purchase price was paid.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, surplus items that do not sell at public surplus auction are hereby authorized to be disposed of in the most economical and cost-effective method.
