

**OKANOGAN COUNTS COMMISSIONERS'**

**RESOLUTION 69 - 2022**

*A Resolution ordering closure of the Okanogan County Courthouse due to scheduled power outage June 3, 2022*

**WHEREAS**, the Okanogan County Code Chapter 2.20.020 provides for the County Courthouse to open at 8:30 a.m. and to close at 5:00 p.m. each Monday through Friday; and

**WHEREAS**, the responsibility for closing county offices comes, in part, from the county commissioners' statutory authority, control, and responsibility over all property of the county; and

**WHEREAS**, a power generator installation project scheduled Friday, June 3, 20200 will require disconnect of power to the courthouse allowing the electrician to complete remaining work AND allow PUD to replace the transformer in the same area as the new generator; and

**WHEREAS**, resolution 64-2022 allowed county courthouse staff to use paid administrative leave on Friday, June 3, 2022 for the scheduled courthouse building closure.


**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners that the County Courthouse be closed Friday June 3, 2022 and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDERED** by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners that this resolution be sent as notice of the closure to the news media and directs the Clerk of the Board to post this resolution to the East and West entrances of the Courthouse thereby giving the public additional notice of the closure.
