

OKANOGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS'
RESOLUTION 70 - 2021

A Resolution amending resolution 55-216 to allow two At-Large positions on the Board of Equalization

WHEREAS: RCW 84.48.010, in part, authorizes a Board of Equalization (BOE) that hears appeals on the assessment of personal and real property of the county, and

WHEREAS: RCW 84.48.014, states, in part, that each county Board of Equalization shall consist of not less than three nor more than seven members including alternates. Such members shall be appointed by a majority of the members of the county legislative authority, and shall not be a holder of any elective office nor be an employee of any elected official; and

WHEREAS: resolution 55-2016 approved a three-member Board of Equalization without alternates, and

WHEREAS: for efficient and effective meetings there is a need to approve alternates to serve when a regular member cannot attend a scheduled hearing, and

WHEREAS: authorizing alternate positions on the Board of Equalization will ensure the minimum number of members are available to attend hearings, and

WHEREAS: The Okanogan Board of County Commissioners finds that it will serve the public interest to authorize a three-member board of equalization with two alternates,


BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED: the Okanogan Board of County Commissioners hereby amends resolution 55-2016 to authorize two alternate positions on the Board of Equalization who will serve when any regular member is unable to attend a scheduled hearing,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: any person appointed to an alternate position is required to attend the department of revenue school for training within one year of appointment.
