WHEREAS, the current Juvenile Services Director/Court Administrator has submitted his resignation effective June 5, 2024; and


WHEREAS, the duties performed by the Juvenile Services Director/Court Administrator requires adequate, and substantial, training for a new employee to be successful; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners reviewed the needs of the Superior Court in regards to training a new Superior Court Administrator, along with the Court's request to allow the current Juvenile Services Director/Court Administrator to work two additional weeks beyond his anticipated resignation date to help facilitate the transition prior to the departure of the current Juvenile Services Director/Court Administrator.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners that the current Juvenile Services Director/Court Administrator be allowed to work two additional weeks (through June 19, 2024) at his current salary for the purpose of training both the new Juvenile Services Director and the Superior Court Administrator.
