RESOLUTION 74 - 2022

Limited commercial use for solid waste drop box facilities.

WHEREAS, in accordance with R.C.W 36.58.020 any Board of County Commissioners may make such rules and regulation as may deemed necessary for the use and occupation of such sites; and

WHEREAS, Public Works request to limit the load size accepted at our remote Drop Box facilities; and

WHEREAS, Okanogan County Public Works drop box facilities are designed for residential and small commercial loads; and

WHEREAS, Okanogan County's populations and waste tonnage have increased such that these small drop box facilities cannot continue to accommodate large commercial and industrial loads such as dump trucks & large dump trailers without adverse impact on the Solid Waste system.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners that effective July 1st, 2022, all dump trucks and dump trailers over four cubic yards will not be allowed to use the Counties Drop Box location, and must use Central Landfill for disposal; and

BE IF FURTHER RESOLVED that WUTC haulers, municipality haulers and single axle cargo/box vans, typically used for moving purpose are exempt.
