

**OKANOGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**

**RESOLUTION 76-2022**

*A resolution setting a maximum amount of \$20,000 in the Drug Task Force checking account*

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Resolution 07-2003, the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners set an amount of \$20,000 to be placed in the Okanogan County Narcotics Task Force undercover checking account; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Resolution 016-2012, the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners reduced the maximum amount to \$10,000 due to budget restraints and lack of funding; and

**WHEREAS**, the economy has changed significantly since the current limit was set by Resolution in 2012 and the budget restraints and lack of funding are no longer impacting the task force budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the name of the Okanogan County Narcotics Task Force was changed to the North Central Washington Narcotics Task Force in 2013; and

**WHEREAS**, the North Central Washington Narcotics Drug Task Force has requested an increase in the undercover checking account due to increasing drug enforcement activities;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the Okanogan County Board of County Commissioners rescinds Resolutions 07-2003 and 016-2012 and any other Resolution establishing a maximum amount for the undercover checking account; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the North Central Washington Narcotics Task Force maximum checking account balance is set at \$20,000.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Okanogan County Treasurer is hereby directed to issue a Treasurer's check in the amount of \$10,000 to the Drug Task Force for the undercover checking account.
