RESOLUTION 89 - 2021**

*A resolution moving Fairgrounds Maintenance positions from Courthouse Maintenance budget to Fairgrounds and Facilities budget*

**WHEREAS**, the Fairgrounds has one temporary seasonal Maintenance Technician, one full-time Buildings & Grounds Maintenance Technician, and one full-time Maintenance Coordinator; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fairgrounds operates as its own department within current expense under the Board of County Commissioners; and

**WHEREAS**, the Events Coordinator position has been reclassified to the Fairgrounds/ Facilities Manager to oversee all operations at the Fairgrounds to include maintenance activities; and

**WHEREAS**, the three maintenance positions that work at the Fairgrounds are currently within the Courthouse Maintenance budget (001.009) and should reside within the Fairgrounds and Facilities budget (001.028); and

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of Okanogan County to operate safe, efficient, and well-maintained County grounds for the public.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners that the following positions be removed from the Courthouse Maintenance budget (001.009) and added to the Fairgrounds and Facilities budget (001.028).
