

**OKANOGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS'**

**RESOLUTION 90 - 2022**

*A resolution converting temporary labor positions to two full time permanent recycling/transfer station operator positions.*

**WHEREAS**, Okanogan County Public works currently hires two Labors, and one Operator Mechanic for six months during the summer and no winter temps; and

**WHEREAS**, Okanogan County Public Works has recently received an additional grant from the Department of Ecology for little clean up, requiring the County to hire two or more summer Temp positions; and

**WHEREAS**, in the past, it has been difficult for the Okanogan County Solid Waste Department to hire temporary labor during the summer; and

**WHEREAS**, Okanogan County Public Works has not been able to utilize trusties for landfill litter collection over the past 3 years due to the lack of trusties; and

**WHEREAS**, Converting the four part time positions to two full time positions will add stability to our litter efforts, and other house keeping issues that we face year-round; and

**WHEREAS**, Converting four temporary positions to permanent positions will allow more flexibility to better serve and meet the needs of the public.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners that effective June 21, 2022, that the two summer temp positions and two litter crew positions will be converted into two full time Recycle/Transfer Station/Equipment Operator positions; and

**BE IF FURTHER RESOLVED** that a total of one temporary Operator/Mechanic remain in effect for the central landfill summer seasons.
