RESOLUTION 92 - 2023

A resolution authorizing a budget supplemental appropriation within the Public Works Parks and Rec Fund 125 to create a new section for work separate from Snowmobile uses for the Engineering Tech position

WHEREAS, the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners (BOCC) approved the County's 2023 Current Expense budget including Public Works, Special, and Miscellaneous fund budgets via resolution 192-2022; and

WHEREAS, Methow Trails maintains and is responsible for with the County's trail system in the Methow Valley through a 35-year Franchise Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Lower Goat Creek Bridge provides public access to portions of the trail on the trail system and it sustained significant damage that require extensive repairs for which the county commissioners agreed to pay for with county ARPA Funds; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was first set on said budget supplemental appropriation on July 25, 2023, at 10:50 a.m. to hear public testimony for or against the supplemental and a notice of said hearing was published in the official legal newspaper of Okanogan County, as required by law; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners that the following BARS lines shall be supplemented and appropriated as conveyed below:
