

**OKANOGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS'**

**RESOLUTION 96 -2022**

*Limited commercial use for drop box facilities.*

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with R.C.W 36.58.020 any Board of County Commissioners may make such rules and regulation as may deemed necessary for the use and occupation of such sites; and

**WHEREAS**, Public Works requests to limit the load size utilizing our remote Drop Box facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, Okanogan County Public Works drop box facilities are designed for residential and small commercial loads; and

**WHEREAS**, Okanogan County's populations and tonnage have outgrown these small drop box facilities, necessitating restrictions on large commercial vehicle access; and

**WHEREAS**, if we continue to allow large industrial vehicles such as dump trucks & large dump trailers access to these facilities, it will have an adverse effect on the County Solid Waste System.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners that effective August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022, dump trucks of any size and all dump trailers over 8 cubic yards will not be allowed to use the Counties Drop Box location, and must use Central Landfill for disposal; and


**BE IF FURTHER RESOLVED** that WUTC haulers, municipalities' haulers, and single axle cargo/box vans typically used for moving purpose are exempt from this restriction; and

**BE IF FURTHER RESOLVED** that Resolution 74 - 2022 is hereby rescinded.
