A resolution to create a Noxious Weed Department Uniforms BARS Code in the Noxious Weed Department Budget

WHEREAS, The Noxious Weed Control Board has established and approved of a Noxious Weed Department Uniform Policy to ensure that Noxious Weed Office Employees present a professional appearance and to make those employees easily identifiable to the public while working outside of the Noxious Weed Office; and

WHEREAS, The Noxious Weed Control Board has provided the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners a copy of the Noxious Weed Department Uniform Policy as attachment A fastened hereto; and

WHEREAS, At the June 28, 2023 Noxious Weed Control Board Meeting the Weed Board members approved the purchasing of Noxious Weed Department Uniforms in the amount of up to \$1,500 per year; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners believes Noxious Weed Department workers should present a professional appearance and should be easily identifiable to the public; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BARS Codes shall be created or assigned within the Noxious Weed Department Budget to allow for the purchasing of Noxious Weed Department Uniforms as set forth within the Noxious Weed Department's Uniform Policy as Atlach ment "A"

Attachment A

Noxious Weed Department Uniform Policy

PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The Uniform Policy of the Okanogan County Noxious Weed Control Board is established to ensure that Noxious Weed Office Employees present a professional appearance and will be easily identifiable to the public.

DEFINITIONS

Serviceable Condition - Neat, clean, and without rips, tears, or holes

WEARING AND CONDITION OF UNIFORM AND EQUIPMENT

Noxious Weed Office Employees must wear a uniform while working outside of the Noxious Weed Office to present a professional appearance and to ensure they are easily identifiable to the public.

- (a) The Noxious Weed Uniform shall include a large Noxious Weed Control Board emblem on the back, a small Noxious Weed Control Board emblem over the left breast area with the Employee's name above the emblem.
- (b) The Noxious Weed Uniform shall consist of one (or more) of the following items:
 - 1. T Shirt (with required information)
 - 2. Long Sleeve Shirt (with required information)
 - 3. Sweatshirt (with required information)
- (c) Uniform shall be worn in conjunction with full length Jeans or Slacks that are in Serviceable Condition, and footwear that is appropriate for the work to be performed (all of these items shall be conservative attire, suitable for working and dealing with the public).
- (d) Uniform shall be maintained in a serviceable condition. It is the Employee's responsibility to notify their supervisor if a uniform item becomes unserviceable or is damaged or lost and requires replacement.
- (e) Uniforms are only to be worn while at work, while in transit to or from work or training, or at other official functions or events.
- (f) Variations from this order are allowed at the discretion of the Manager or his/her Designee.

OFFICE-ISSUED IDENTIFICATION

Okanogan County issues each Employee an official office identification card bearing the Employee's name, identifying information and photo likeness. All Employees shall be in possession of their office identification card at all times while at work, and shall display their county-issued identification card in a courteous manner to any person upon request.

IN-OFFICE ATTIRE

When working inside the Noxious Weed Office, Noxious Weed Office Employees may wear personal clothing with the following requirements:

- (a) All Employees shall wear clothing that fits properly, is clean, and not damaged or excessively worn.
- (b) The following items shall not be worn at work:
 - 1. Swimsuits, tube tops, or halter-tops.
 - 2. Spandex type pants or see-through clothing.
 - 3. Distasteful printed slogans, buttons, or pins.
- (c) Variations from this order are allowed at the discretion of the Manager or his/her Designee when the Employee's assignment or current task is not conducive to the wearing of such clothing.

(d) No item of personal attire may be worn at work that would adversely affect the reputation of the Okanogan County Noxious Weed Office or the morale of other Employees.

POLICY

The Okanogan County Noxious Weed Control Board shall provide uniforms for all employees who are required to wear them in the manner, quantity, and frequency as approved by the Okanogan County Noxious Weed Control Board. All uniforms and equipment issued to Noxious Weed Office Employees shall be returned to the Noxious Weed Office Manager upon termination or resignation.
