RESOLUTION 103 – 2021

A resolution authorizing a budget supplemental appropriation within the Jail Improvement Fund 193 in the amount of \$5,432

WHEREAS, the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners (BOCC) approved the County's 2021 Current Expense budget including Special and Miscellaneous fund budgets via resolution 183-2020; and

WHEREAS, the current jail heating and cooling system actuators must be replaced as they are aged and inefficient causing insufficient airflow in the building; and

WHEREAS, replacing the aged actuators will provide much improved airflow and air quality in the jail; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to properly appropriate budget for the expenditure; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was first set on said budget supplemental appropriation on August 16, 2021, at 11:00 a.m. to hear public testimony for or against the supplemental; and

WHEREAS, a notice of said hearing was published in the official legal newspaper of Okanogan County, as required by law;
