**RESOLUTION 109 – 2021**

*A resolution authorizing a budget supplemental appropriation within Current Expense Prosecutor fund 001.016 in the amount of \$140,000*

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners (BOCC) approved the County's 2021 Current Expense budget including Special and Miscellaneous fund budgets via resolution 183-2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the costs of Professional Services for civil litigation services has increased substantially due to the Methow Rule litigation, litigation with the Colville Tribes, the Comprehensive Plan and the Environmental Impact Study; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to appropriate budget to cover the expenditures so that the Prosecutor can pay the county litigation expenses; and

**WHEREAS**, a Public Hearing was first set on said budget supplemental appropriation on August 31, 2021, at 2:10 p.m. and continued September 1, 2021 9:05 a.m. to hear public testimony for or against the supplemental; and

**WHEREAS**, a notice of said hearing was published in the official legal newspaper of Okanogan County, as required by law;
