RESOLUTION 117 - 2021

A resolution to convert the vacant Noxious Weed Lead Field Technician position to a Field Technician position

WHEREAS, The Noxious Weed Control Board has been unable to successfully fill a vacant Lead Field Technician position due to applicants not having the required experience for the position; and

WHEREAS, At the July 28, 2021 Noxious Weed Control Board Meeting the Weed Board members requested that the Noxious Weed Board Manager change the vacant Lead Field Technician position into a Field Technician position to allow the office to be fully staffed; and

WHEREAS, the Manager has expressed a desire to hire a Field Technician at this time and to work towards training a Lead Field Technician within the Noxious Weed Office to be promoted at a later date; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners to enable their Departments to operate in an efficient and effective manner to serve the public.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners that the vacant Noxious Weed Lead Field Technician position be converted to a Field Technician position.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the vacant Lead Field Technician BARS Code shall be assigned to the Field Technician position as necessary.
