**RESOLUTION 121 - 2021**

*A Resolution Authorizing a Regular Part-Time Administrative Services Officer through the Okanogan County Juvenile Court*

**WHEREAS**, the Juvenile Court employs both full-time and part-time employees to fulfill the judicial needs for Okanogan County; and

**WHEREAS**, Heather Spaet was appointed by the Juvenile Court Administrator in 2007 to serve as a full-time Administrative Services Officer; and

**WHEREAS**, upon hire Heather Spaet was classified as a full-time employee pursuant to Okanogan County Policies; however, the employee has made the request to become a regular part-time employee; and

**WHEREAS**, Okanogan County Personnel Policies Manual section 4.1.2 establishes the criteria for regular part-time employees; and


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners that Heather Spaet be re-classified as a regular part-time employee pursuant to Okanogan County Personnel Policies Manual section 4.1.2 effective September 7, 2021.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the status and classification of the position may be further modified and changed at the discretion of the Juvenile Court Administrator based upon the Juvenile Courts business needs and demands with approval of the Board of County Commissioners.
