RESOLUTION 122 - 2020

A resolution authorizing a budget supplemental within Current Expense Planning Department

WHEREAS, the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners (BOCC) approved the County's 2020 Current Expense budget including Special and Miscellaneous fund budgets via resolution 156-2019 as amended by resolution 169-2019; and

WHEREAS, the Methow Valley Trails (aka MVSTA) is building a trailhead on the county owned trail and a grant is paying for the vaulted toilet being placed there, but funds were not previously budgeted for this purchase; and

WHEREAS, budget must be appropriated within the Planning Department fund for the cost of the vaulted toilet purchased for Methow Trails; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was first set on said supplemental appropriation on September 22, 2020, at 3:00 p.m. to hear public testimony for or against the budget supplemental; and

WHEREAS, a notice of said hearing was published in the official legal newspaper of Okanogan County, as required by law;
