**RESOLUTION 126 -2020**

*A resolution allowing the Emergency Management Department to use County employees*

**WHEREAS**, there are times when Okanogan County is under a declared state of emergency or an incident is under way; and

**WHEREAS**, Emergency Management may need extra help to offer support to agencies during these times; and

**WHEREAS**, employees of other departments or offices may have the time and/or skills to aid these efforts; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners want to ensure the safety of our citizens and employees and to have the necessary resources to do so.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners that effective during a declared state of emergency or an incident, Emergency Management may request the assistance of County employees to help after consulting and coordinating with the employees' Department Head/Elected Official.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that these employees shall be paid at their regular rate of pay from BARS Code 121.012.000.525.60.10.00 in the Emergency Management budget.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, that a payroll change notice shall be completed for each employee signed by Emergency Management and the employee's Elected Official/Department Head before being sent to Human Resources for processing.


