

**OKANOGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
RESOLUTION 127 - 2020**

A resolution authorizing full-time Custodian position

WHEREAS, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Courts have moved some court functions to the Fairgrounds Agriplex building and intend to move again to another building to be purchased to address pandemic precautionary requirements for public safety; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners recognizes the necessity for an additional custodian to perform routine cleaning in the Courthouse Complex that will provide public safety measures; and

WHEREAS, the duties of the custodian will be utilized for the courts in general to include Superior Courtroom at the Fairgrounds Agriplex, new building once purchased, Superior Courtroom, Jail Courtroom, District Court Courtrooms, and any additional cleaning at the Courthouse Complex in order to provide cleanliness for public use and to facilitate compliance with COVID-19 measures; and

WHEREAS, the workload of the Maintenance Department is such that an additional full-time custodial position is needed to provide the additional measure of sanitization and cleanliness of frequently used public spaces; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of County Commissioners to provide adequate services and support that benefits the citizens and operations of Okanogan County.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners that a full-time custodian position be created to support the Courts and Courthouse Complex effective July 21, 2020. *MNT009CS1-003*

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the BARS Code for said position shall be created by payroll in the Auditor's Office. *001.009.030.518.11.15*
