*A resolution authorizing a budget amendment within Current Expense Prosecutor Budget 001.016 and Veterans Relief Fund 101*

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners (BOCC) approved the County's 2020 Current Expense budget including Special and Miscellaneous fund budgets via resolution 156-2019 as amended by resolution 169-2019; and

**WHEREAS**, the Prosecutor's budget will be overspent due to increased Professional Services due to recent need for expert witness and attorney fees for land use civil litigation and first degree arson cases; and

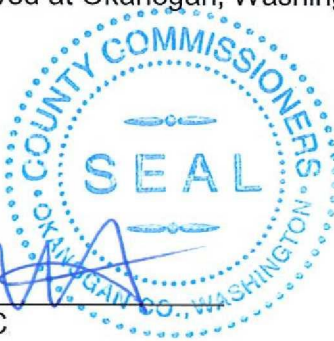
**WHEREAS**, the Veterans Relief fund did not provide sufficient budget for insurance costs; and
