**RESOLUTION 133- 2022**

*A Resolution to surplus cut up utility poles*

**WHEREAS**, the Okanogan County Public Works Department, Solid Waste Division, has requested to surplus cut up utility poles from the Cold Springs Fire, and

**WHEREAS**, the cut up utility poles were set aside for use by the fire victims to rebuild gates and fences, and

**WHEREAS**, there is no longer a need to reserve the utility poles, and


**WHEREAS**, the Revised Code of Washington, Chapter 36.34.020(3) provides for the disposal of county property, valued at less than \$2,500, without advertising or public hearing.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Okanogan County Board of Commissioners hereby surplus said utility poles and authorize the Director of Public Works to make said utility poles available to the public for no charge, first-come-first-served.
