RESOLUTION 138 - 2021

A resolution amending resolution 67-2021 regarding proposed levels of assessment for horticultural pests and disease control in Okanogan County

WHEREAS, the Okanogan County Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) approved resolution 67-2021 which adopted proposed levels of assessment for horticultural pests and disease control within Okanogan County for collection in 2022; and

WHEREAS, the proposed per parcel assessment included all parcels at \$1.61/per parcel (46,100 taxable parcels) combined with the commercial planted orchard acre assessment of \$2.25/per acre (27,103 tree fruit acres); and

WHEREAS, the County Assessor cannot calculate \$1.61 accurately due to the amount being an odd number and therefore requested the BOCC amend the amount to be collected for accuracy purposes; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that resolution 67-2021 is hereby amended to change the 2022 assessment from \$1.61 to \$1.60 so that the Okanogan County Horticultural, Pest and Disease Control Assessment levy for 2022 shall be \$1.60 per parcel for all classified lands within Okanogan County including but not limited to: orchard lands, dry lands, range lands, irrigated lands, forestlands, and/or state and federal lands combined with the commercial planted orchard acre assessment of \$2.25/per acre (27,103 tree fruit acres; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED all other recitals of resolution 67-2021 shall remain in effect; and,

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Okanogan County Assessor and the Okanogan County Treasurer are hereby directed to perform the necessary duties to comply with this resolution and RCW 15.09.135.
