Resolution 160 - 2021

A resolution rescinding resolution 85-2021 a previous Emergency Declaration for hazardous conditions.

WHEREAS, on July 6, 2021, Governor Jay Inslee declared a statewide state of emergency relating to the growing risk of wildfire in Washington State due to historic drought and record-breaking heat; and

WHEREAS; Resolution 85-2021 declared an emergency existed in Okanogan County due to lightning caused fires in the Cedar Creek and Cub Creek areas of the Methow Valley; and

WHEREAS; Okanogan County received significant rainfall since the emergency was declared and all fire danger is past.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Okanogan County Commissioner does hereby rescind resolution 85-2021 in its entirety.
