RESOLUTION 164 - 2022

Authorizing a Residential Appraiser II in the Assessor's Office

WHEREAS, the Assessor has requested one additional Residential Appraiser II to meet the workload within the Assessor's office; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners to enable the Assessor's Office to perform appraisals throughout the County in an efficient and effective manner; and

WHEREAS, upon completion of a training period, up to the date of the required State course and test, usually held in September or October, and successful completion of the testing as a Residential Appraiser II, the State will issue a Certification of Completion for becoming a Residential Appraiser III;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED effective January 1, 2023 the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners approve the addition of one Residential Appraiser II position.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners that effective January 1, 2023, the Residential Appraiser II Position #ASR003ARA2-004 be approved until they receive their Residential Appraiser Certification at which time the Residential Appraiser II will move to a Residential Appraiser III and this position will be funded using BARS Code 001.003.000.514.21.11.07.


