RESOLUTION 171 - 2021

A resolution creating a Network Analyst within the Central Services Department

WHEREAS, the Director of Central Services met with the Board of County Commissioners and stated the current System Administrator would be retiring; and

WHEREAS, the Director feels it would be best to create a second Network Analyst position while current staff continue to train to the level of a System Administrator as the position requires extensive training and knowledge of county systems and networks; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of County Commissioners to provide adequate services to the citizens of Okanogan County.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that there may be an allowance of two Network Analysts or at one time or one Network Analyst and one System Administrator depending upon need and skill level.


