RESOLUTION 178-2023

A resolution granting Coroner and staff a work wear allowance

WHEREAS, the Coroner and his deputy gather evidence and information, interact with police officers, judges, lawyers, medical examiners and forensic scientists; and

WHEREAS, the Coroner and his deputy may perform duties outside in inclement weather which could include rain, hail, snow, cold, high wind, dust storm, high temperature, or any combination thereof; and


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners believes the Coroner and his Deputy should be protected from hazardous weather;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Coroner and his deputy are allowed to be reimbursed up to \$200 each per year for boots that are suitable of the work performed.
