## **RESOLUTION 180 - 2020**

A resolution authorizing general wage increase for Non-Bargaining employees

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners has the authority to approve periodic adjustments to the Non-Bargaining pay plan; and

WHEREAS, the last general wage increase authorized for Non-Bargaining employees was in 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, the County recognizes the value of adopting a pay plan that promotes the recruitment and retention of employees.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners that effective January 1, 2021, Non-Bargaining employees are granted a general wage increase of 1.5% to the base salary (Attachment A) hereby adopting a new Classification Plan.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** this resolution shall not change or limit other benefits not listed that covered employees currently have through their employment with the County and does include appointed and contracted employees.
