RESOLUTION 180 - 2022

A resolution to amend Okanogan Counties Portion of the Prosecutors Salary

WHEREAS, RCW 36.17.020 provides that the County Commissioners of each county are authorized to establish the salaries of the Elected Officials of the County; and

WHEREAS, RCW 36.40.205 allows for salary adjustments, by resolution, prior to the election for any county legislative authority office; and

WHEREAS, resolution 156-2017 set the County's share of the Prosecuting Attorney's salary at \$4,813.75 monthly or \$57,765 yearly and RCW 36.17.020(11) states "The state of Washington shall contribute an amount equal to one-half the salary of a Superior Court Judge towards the salary of the elected Prosecuting Attorney. Upon receipt of the state contribution, the county shall continue to contribute towards the salary of the elected Prosecuting Attorney in the amount that equals or exceeds that contributed by the county in 2008."; and


WHEREAS, the County's share of the Prosecuting Attorney's salary has not been increased since 2017 and a salary survey showed that the Prosecuting Attorney's salary is below Okanogan County's comparable Counties; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners that the Okanogan County portion of the Prosecutors salary be \$67,415.50 yearly beginning 1/01/2023.
