

OKANOGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS'

RESOLUTION 181 - 2020

A resolution providing a Stipend to Probation Manager for additional responsibilities associated with Washington for the Housing for Youth in Courts (HSYNC) Project.

WHEREAS, the University of Washington Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Services allocated funding to the Okanogan County Juvenile Court to serve high risk youth through community programs particularly to address youth homelessness; and

WHEREAS, the funding for programs is from November 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021, with the possibility of additional funding into the SFY 2021-22; and

WHEREAS, funding for Juvenile Services can be utilized for the purpose of hiring a homeless youth coordinator to engage youth and families to achieve specific, obtainable changes related to homelessness that may lead to contact with the juvenile justice system; and

WHEREAS, the Juvenile Probation Manager, Mike Beaver, possesses the knowledge, skills and abilities that will provide counseling and coordination services pursuant to the recognized evidence-based programs for at-risk youth and their families using standards developed by the University of Washington; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board that the Department of Juvenile and Family Services provide the community with the best available resources to serve at-risk homeless youth;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners that effective November 1, 2020, the Probation Manager will receive a monthly stipend in the amount of \$1,875 a month. The stipend will only continue as long as funding is received from the University of Washington for the Housing for Youth in Courts (HSYNC) Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that hours committed to the program will be beyond the normal forty-hour workweek for the Juvenile Probation Manager position.




