

OKANOGAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS'

RESOLUTION 187 - 2020

WHEREAS, as an option of the county legislative authority, some of the levy capacity of the County Road Fund may be shifted to increase the Current Expense Fund; and

WHEREAS, RCW 84.52.043 allows the shift between these two funds to take place; and

WHEREAS, said levy shift is needed in order to offset substantial revenue losses to the county associated with increased unfunded state and federal mandates and increased cost of goods and services; and

WHEREAS, said levy shift is needed to retain a certain level of services; and,

WHEREAS, no levy shift monies are owed to the cities and there is no need to buy down the levy rate to the cities; and

WHEREAS, said levy shift enables the general operating budget of the county to receive additional operating revenues that will help maintain a certain level of service throughout the year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners that a Road Fund levy shift is hereby authorized in the amount of \$300,000 payable to the 2021 Okanogan County Current Expense Fund #001.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds for said Road Fund Levy Shift come from 2021 property taxes collected and received by the County Current Expense Fund #001.


