RESOLUTION 192 - 2023

A resolution setting Elected Official's Chief Deputy salaries

WHEREAS, RCW 36.16.070 allows for Elected Officials to employ deputies and other necessary employees with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the appointed Chief Deputies require a knowledge base to mirror that of the Elected Official to run the office in the Elected Official's absence; and

WHEREAS, the deputies have the same authority as their Elected Official to carry out the duties and responsibilities of that Elected Official's office; and

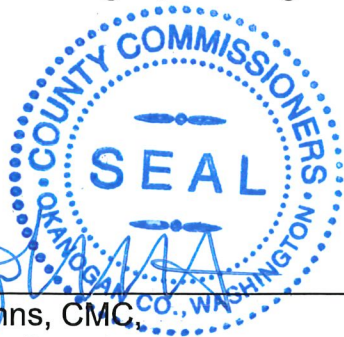
WHEREAS, it is necessary to maintain internal alignment between the Chief Deputies, office staff, and Elected Officials, to reflect the complexity of duties and level of responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, Section 3.3.1 of the County Personnel Manual provides for the appointment at a higher salary on the Non-Bargaining pay chart upon the approval of the Board of County Commissioners; and


WHEREAS, Resolution 48-2021 set the salaries of the Elected Official's Chief Deputies at eighty-five (85%) of their Elected Official's salary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners that effective January 1, 2024, and henceforth thereafter until changed by resolution of the BOCC the salaries of Elected Official's Chief Deputy's; Chief Deputy Assessor, Chief Deputy Auditor, Chief Deputy Clerk, Chief Deputy Treasurer, and Chief Deputy Coroner salaries shall be eight-five (85%) of their Elected Official's salary computed the first day of every year; and
