RESOLUTION 194 - 2022

A resolution restoring unused sick leave for Anthony Hawley

WHEREAS, Anthony Hawley was elected Okanogan County Sheriff in the November 2018 general election; and

WHEREAS, prior to his election as the Okanogan County Sheriff, Mr. Hawley had accumulated sick leave of 480 hours; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Hawley was defeated in this reelection bid for Okanogan County Sheriff in the November 2022 general election; and

WHEREAS, on January 1, 2023 Mr. Hawley will return to his previously held civil service position as a commissioned officer in the Okanogan County Sheriff's Office as provided for by RCW 41.04.120; and,

WHEREAS, said RCW preserves the rights of any civil service employee "who is on leave of absence by reason of having been elected or appointed to an elective office."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners that the 480 hours of sick leave accumulated by Anthony Hawley prior to his election as the county sheriff will be restored upon his appointment as a commissioned officer effective January 1, 2023.


