RESOLUTION 2 – 2023

A resolution authorizing Tonasket Emergency Medical Services Levy to be collected in 2024 and increasing the percentage to be collected as allowed by law

WHEREAS, the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners, as the governing body of the taxing district of Tonasket Emergency Medical District, has met and considered the Tonasket EMS District budget for the calendar year 2024; and,

WHEREAS, the district's actual levy amount from the previous year was \$226,022; and,

WHEREAS, the population of this district is less than 10,000; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on November 6, 2023 in accordance with RCW 84.55.120 on the district's budget which is primarily funded by taxes and charges and reflects the provision of ongoing services; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the taxing district that an increase in the regular property tax levy is hereby authorized for the levy to be collected in the 2024 tax year.

The dollar amount of the increase over the actual levy amount from the previous year shall be \$2,260, which is a percentage increase of 1% from the previous year. This increase is exclusive of additional revenue resulting from new construction, improvements to property, newly constructed wind turbines, any increase in the value of state assessed property, any annexations that have occurred, and refunds made.
